TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Deemed/Instant/Auto-generated Municipal Health Trade license certificate availed is restricted within the domain of regulatory actions of the Public Health Department to ensure operation of the Health trade under sanitary and hygienic conditions by complying with the technical conditions prescribed for the Health trades
2. The Health Trade License regulates the operation of health trades from the perspective of public safety, health, hygiene, sanitation, and food safety within the jurisdiction of the Municipal Corporation of Delhi
3. This licensee will completely indemnify the MCD for any incidence of fire. Fire Safety Standards are to be taken care of by the licensee. Applicant who is seeking for HTL shall obtain fire NOC. Licensee will be squarely responsible for fire safety of the premises and meeting other regulatory requirement as applicable.
4. Deemed/Health Trade License does not confer any legal/ownership right and cannot be used for any other purpose for which license is generated.
5. Deemed/license does not entitle for regularization of any unauthorized construction.
6. The licensee shall permit the authorized officer of MCD to inspect the licensed premises consequent to issue of deemed health trade license under question at all reasonable time and without notice during the tenure/ validity of license.
7. Whenever the licensed premises are vacated, the licensee shall inform to the concerned authorized officer of MCD and liable to return/surrender the license to MCD. Failure to do so shall make him/her ineligible for issue of license in future, without getting cleared all previous dues.
8. The licensee shall maintain the premises under sanitary & hygienic condition at all times and shall ensure timely removal and disposal of filth, refuse, grease, and waste in accordance with applicable Solid Waste Management Rules and municipal requirements.
9. The licensee shall make separate storage arrangement for the articles which are intended for human consumption and which are poisonous or likely to contaminate other items within the premises.
10. The licensee shall ensure that no act is being done in the licensed premises which shall lead to danger to life or property, nuisance etc.
11. Licensee shall either do not permit any negligent act, which is likely to cause fire or otherwise endanger the public safety in the licensed premises.
12. The licensee shall not encroach upon public land by placing tables, chairs, cooking equipment, or any other articles outside the licensed premises in a manner that may obstruct sanitation, waste management, drainage, or public movement.
13. The license is subject to all terms and conditions imposed at time of grant of health trade license and also imposed from time to time. If it is found that the activity is not permissible, then license shall stand revoked without any further communication and MCD shall be kept harmless for the same
14. The grant of license does not abdicate the licensee from responsibilities as towards complying with the provisions of DMC Act, 1957 as amended from time to time or any other law for the time being in force.
15. The licensee shall not be allowed to run any trade which is prohibited by any Act/Law/Government order / Directions from any Court of Law.
16. The health trade license is premises specific. Any change in the premises including addition/alteration or ownership will amount to revocation of license issued.
17. The license shall be liable to cancellation if any statement, declaration, undertaking, or document submitted by the applicant is found to be false, misleading, or misrepresented in any material respect. In such cases, the deemed license shall be treated as void ab initio, and any misuse of the license shall be dealt with in accordance with Sections 417, 420, 421, 422, 423, 397 & 430 of the Delhi Municipal Corporation Act, 1957, and rules made there under.
18. In cases of violations, the licensee may be given reasonable time for compliance, or ordinarily not exceeding three weeks, failing which the deemed license status will be revoked and appropriate regulatory action initiated as per law.
19. Where conditions are observed that pose a risk to public health, hygiene, or sanitation, the Municipal Corporation of Delhi may take immediate regulatory action, including inspection, sampling, suspension, or cancellation of license in accordance with applicable provisions of law.
20. The health trade license issued is subject to the validity of documents submitted by the applicant. Any violation to the technical instructions & bye-laws for the health trades will result in revocation of the license and MCD Will not be liable for the same.
21. Licensee will be squarely responsible for fire safety of the premises and also other regulatory Stake Holders will have to fulfill their regulatory roles as per their domain of actions.
22. As per the domain of regulatory actions, operation of the Health trade under sanitary and hygienic conditions by complying with the technical conditions prescribed for the Health trades under the Health Bye Laws will be ensured and accordingly indemnify MCD against any incidence of fire accidents.
23. The establishment shall develop and maintain written Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for food preparation, storage, cleaning and sanitation, pest control, waste management, and emergency response, and such SOPs shall be made available for inspection by the competent authority.
24. The establishment shall maintain records of cleaning schedules, pest control activities, temperature monitoring, equipment maintenance, and food safety checks, and such records shall be preserved on the premises for inspection by the competent authority.
25. All food handlers shall receive basic training in food hygiene and safe food handling practices appropriate to their duties, and records of such training shall be maintained at the premises. A responsible person in charge shall be present during operating hours to supervise food safety, hygiene, sanitation, and compliance with these guidelines within the establishment.
26. Any incident of suspected food contamination, foodborne illness, or unsafe food condition associated with the establishment shall be reported promptly to the competent authority, and necessary corrective actions shall be

undertaken without delay.

27. The establishment shall conduct routine inspection of the premises and incoming food supplies to detect pest activity, spoilage, contamination, or other unsafe conditions and shall take immediate corrective action wherever required.
28. Random inspection of the trade premises can be carried out by the authorized officials of the Public Health Department at any time. Inspection may not be compulsory during the renewal of the license for fourth/fifth and sixth financial years, but, compulsory after completion of the license cycle of six financial years.
29. The licensing authority may issue written directions or additional conditions, where necessary, to address specific public health risks or sanitation concerns within the establishment.
30. Health Trade License will not have any bearing on ownership and cannot be used for settlement of ownership dispute. It is also not entitled for regularization of any unauthorized construction.
31. Prevention of smoking, tobacco chewing and serving of nicotine in any form will be the sole responsibility of management in entire licensed premises.
